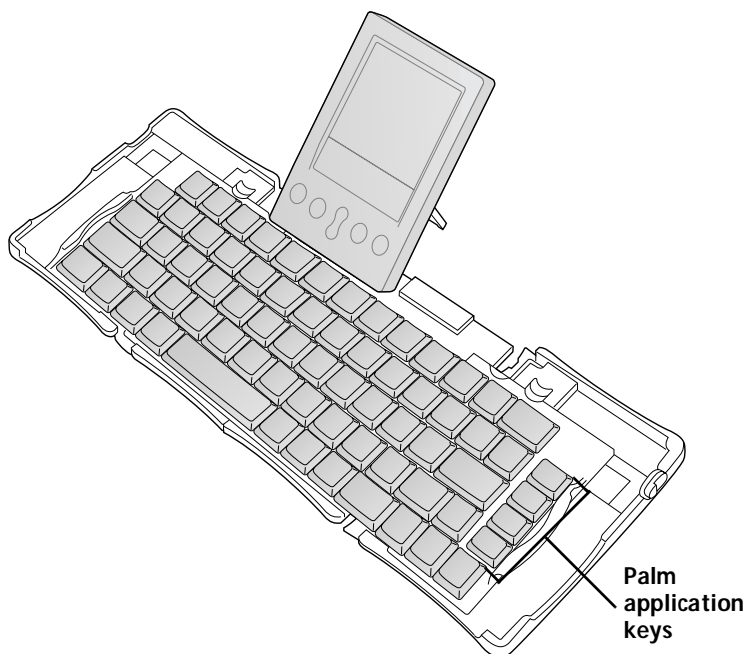

# Introducing the Palm™ Portable Keyboard

The Palm™ Portable Keyboard is the convenient, portable solution for typing text and commands quickly and easily into your Palm Computing® organizer. This compact and fully functional keyboard enables you to do the following:

- Type text and special characters into your Palm applications
- Quickly access your main applications with keyboard buttons
- Enter commands and options with function keys
- Travel anywhere with a keyboard for your organizer



Before you can use your keyboard, you must do the following:

- Install the Palm Portable Keyboard application on your organizer
- Set up the keyboard and attach your Palm Computing organizer

# Installing the Application

Before you install the Palm™ Portable Keyboard application on your organizer, it's a good idea to perform a HotSync® operation to back up your data.

The application for the Palm Portable Keyboard controls the way the portable keyboard interacts with your organizer. It's a PRC file like most other applications for your organizer, and you install Keyboard.prc just like any other application.

**Note:** To use the keyboard with a PalmPilot™ Personal or Professional organizer, you cannot use the PRC included on the CD-ROM. Instead, download the version of Keyboard.prc from the following web site: <http://www.palm.com/custsupp/downloads>

## To load the keyboard application on Windows 95/98:

1. Insert the CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive, and then double-click the CD-ROM drive icon.
2. Copy the Keyboard.prc file from the CD-ROM drive to the Add-on folder in your Palm™ Desktop directory.
3. Click Start in the Windows taskbar.
4. Choose Programs, and then choose Palm Desktop.
5. Choose Install Tool.
6. In the User drop-down list, select the name that corresponds to your organizer.
7. Click Add.
8. Select Keyboard.prc from the list of applications, and then click Open.
9. Click Done.
10. Click OK.

## To load the keyboard application on Macintosh:

1. Exit any open programs, including those in the Startup folder, and disable any virus-scanning software.
2. Insert the CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive.
3. When the folder appears on the desktop, drag the Keyboard.prc file into the Add-on folder in the Palm folder.

4. Double-click the HotSync Manager icon in the Palm folder.
5. Choose Install from the HotSync menu.
6. Drag Keyboard.prc to the Install Handheld Files dialog box.

**To install the keyboard application on your organizer:**

- Perform a HotSync operation to install the application on your organizer.

The icon for the Palm Portable Keyboard application appears in the Applications Launcher.



**Icon of the Palm Portable Keyboard application**

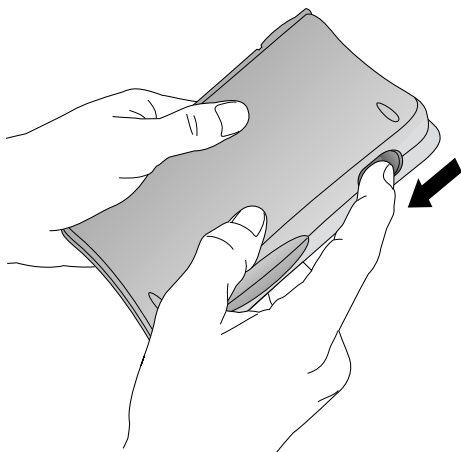
Now you're ready to set up your keyboard.

# Setting Up the Keyboard

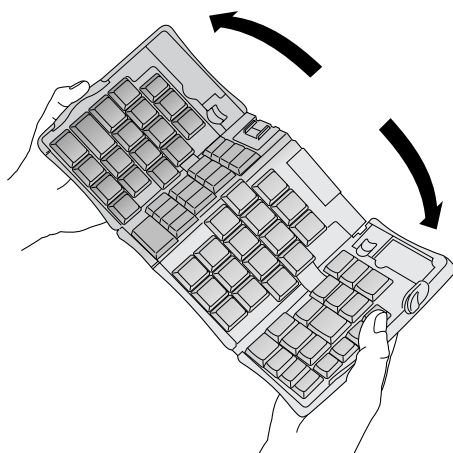
Always use your keyboard on a hard, flat surface.

**To open the keyboard:**

1. Hold the keyboard in your hands and slide the latch down to open the case.

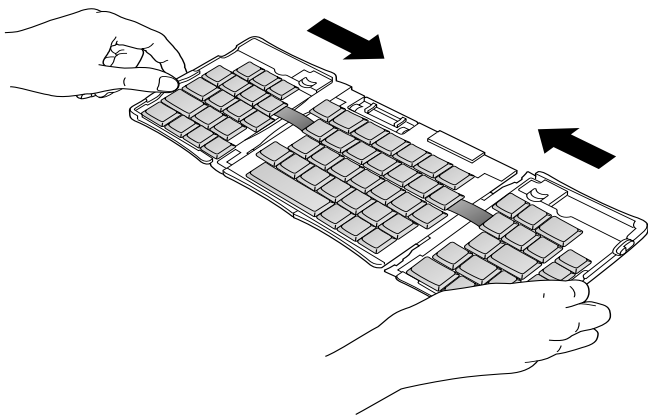


2. Unfold the keyboard and place it on a hard, flat surface.

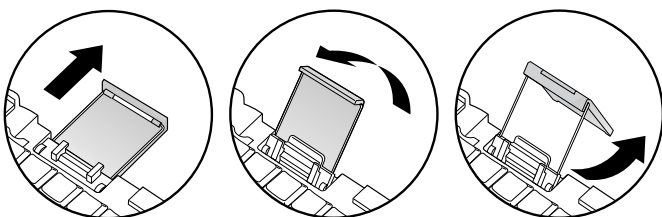




3. Grasp the two side-grips (with red borders) and slide them in toward the keyboard's center until the keyboard sections are completely together.

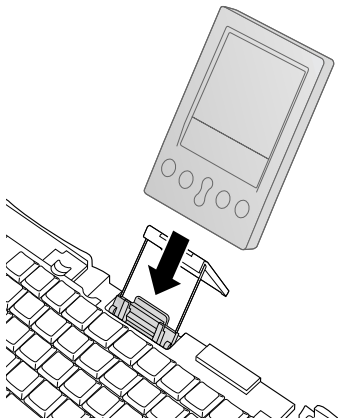


4. While holding the keyboard, slide the docking connector support bracket out until it clicks; then tilt it up and push the flat support outward.



**To connect your organizer:**

1. Line up your organizer with the angle of the support bracket.
2. Slide your organizer securely onto the keyboard docking connector. Your organizer turns on automatically.

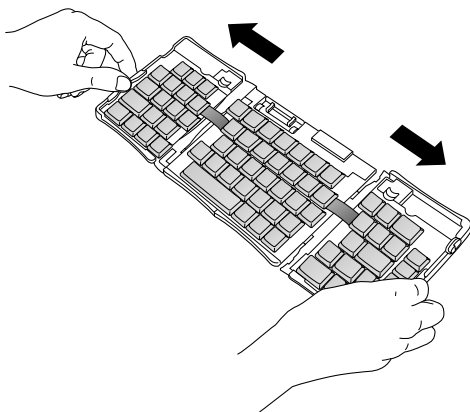


After you install the keyboard application and connect the organizer, you can begin typing.

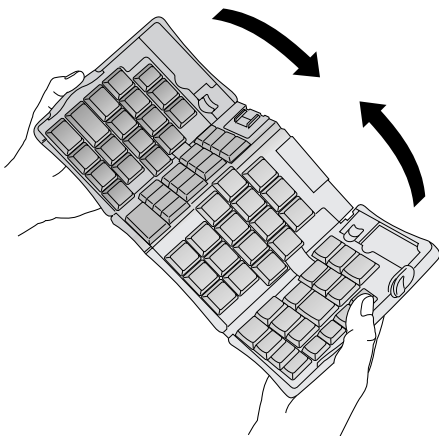
# Closing the Keyboard

When you finish using your keyboard, remove the organizer, unlock and fold up the keyboard, and close it back into a portable case.

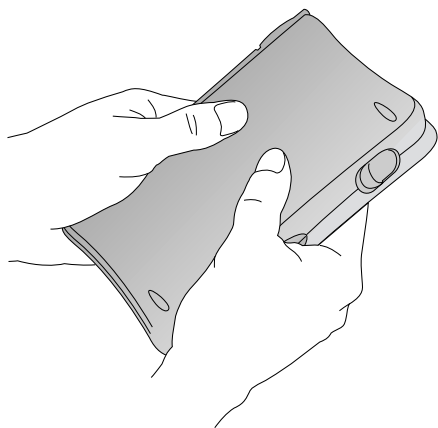
1. Pull your organizer up and away from the docking connector.
2. Fold the docking connector support bracket in and down flat; then slide it back into the keyboard.
3. With your thumbs, slide the side-grips to the outside of the keyboard. Make sure the two outer keyboard sections are as far apart as possible.



4. Fold the center section upward, and bring the left and right sides together. The keyboard now forms a “W.”



5. Continue to fold the keyboard shut. Press the two sides of the case together, and then snap all four corners shut. You feel a click at all four corners.





# Customizing Your Keyboard

You can customize your keyboard using the options available in the keyboard application on your organizer.

## Changing General settings

The General settings control the interaction of the keyboard with the organizer.

To change General settings:

1. Tap the Applications icon .
2. Tap the Keyboard icon .
3. Change the settings.



**Key Repeat Rate:** Drag the indicator to speed up or slow down the rate at which a character is typed when you hold down the key.

**Delay Until Repeat:** Drag the indicator to lengthen or shorten the time between typing the first key to repeat and the appearance of the subsequent repeated keys.

**Test Repeat Settings:** Hold down a key in this edit line to test your selections for Key Repeat Rate and Delay Until Repeat.

**Enable key clicks:** Tap in order to hear a click when you press a key. The System Sound option in the General Preferences for your organizer must also be set to Low, Medium, or High.



**Enable keyboard:** Tap to turn the keyboard driver off and on. The default setting is on (selected).

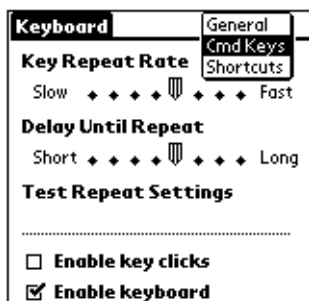
# Assigning applications to command key combinations

You can open the main organizer applications — Date Book, Address Book, To Do List, and Memo Pad — using the four keys on the far right of your portable keyboard.

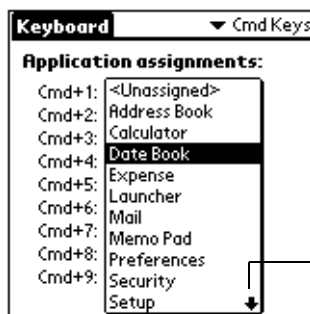
You can also open an application by using a command key combination that you assign to it.

To assign an application to a command key combination:

1. Tap the Applications icon .
2. Tap the Keyboard icon .
3. Tap the pick list in the upper-right corner of the screen and select Cmd Keys.



4. Tap the pick list of the command key combination that you want to assign to an application.
5. Select the application that you want to assign to the key combination.





Tap an arrow to move through the list a page at a time

# Viewing keyboard shortcuts

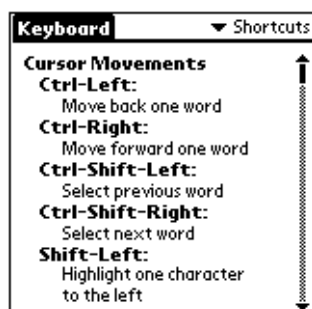
Your keyboard comes with a full set of keyboard shortcuts for performing organizer functions. Use the Shortcuts list to view the available shortcuts.

To view the list of keyboard shortcuts:

1. Tap the Applications icon .
2. Tap the Keyboard icon .
3. Tap the pick list in the upper-right corner and select Shortcuts.



4. Use the onscreen scroll bar or the scroll button on the front panel of your organizer to move through the list.



See “Keyboard Shortcuts” for the keyboard shortcuts that appear in the list on your organizer.

# Keyboard Shortcuts

This section lists the keyboard shortcuts that are available on your portable keyboard.

## Cursor movements

This table lists the shortcuts for moving the cursor and selecting text.

| Shortcut                   | Action                                       |

| Ctrl - Left arrow          | Moves cursor left (back) one word            |
| Ctrl - Right arrow         | Moves cursor right (forward) one word        |
| Ctrl - Shift - Left arrow  | Selects previous word                        |
| Ctrl - Shift - Right arrow | Selects next word                            |
| Shift - Left arrow         | Selects character to the left of the cursor  |
| Shift - Right arrow        | Selects character to the right of the cursor |
| Shift - Up arrow           | Selects previous line                        |
| Shift - Down arrow         | Selects next line                            |
| Cmd - Left arrow           | Moves cursor to the beginning of the line    |
| Cmd - Right arrow          | Moves cursor to the end of the line          |
| Fn - Up arrow              | Scrolls up                                   |
| Fn - Down arrow            | Scrolls down                                 |
| Tab                        | Tabs forward through edit lines              |
| Shift - Tab                | Tabs backward through edit lines             |
| Fn - Tab                   | Inserts a tab in a line                      |



## Button shortcuts

This table lists the key combinations to activate onscreen buttons.

**Note:** You can also activate a button by pressing Ctrl - Cmd and a letter unique to the button name.

| Keystroke        | Equivalent onscreen button |

| Fn - Del         | Delete                     |
| Fn - Done        | Cancel                     |

## Menu commands

This table lists the key combinations to activate organizer commands.

| Keystroke | Action                                       |
|-----------|--|
| Ctrl - x  | Cuts selected text                           |
| Ctrl - c  | Copies selected text                         |
| Ctrl - v  | Pastes cut or copied text                    |
| Fn - Cmd  | Enters shortcut mode                         |
| Fn - =    | Toggles backlight                            |
| Cmd-space | Enters kana mode ( <i>Japanese OS only</i> ) |

# Extended character set

The following two tables list the function key and character combinations to generate extended characters.

**Table 1: Accent marks**

First, type the letter to which you want to add an accent. Then quickly press the function key and the character indicated.

For example, to type the ö in Köln, type the o, and then quickly press Fn and ; (function key and semicolon). The umlaut appears over the o.

| Keystroke | Character example | Description                  |
|-----------|-------------------|------------------------------|
| Fn - '    | á                 | Acute accent                 |
| Fn - ^    | â                 | Circumflex                   |
| Fn - ;    | ä                 | Umlaut                       |

See “Does the keyboard support international characters?” later in this book to learn how to use the Alt key to make the portable keyboard mimic the onscreen international keyboard on your organizer.

## General questions and answers

### Does the keyboard require batteries?

No. The keyboard is designed to use an extremely low amount of power from your organizer.

### Can I use the same keyboard for all organizers?

No. The keyboard is available in two versions, one for the Palm III™ organizer and the other for the Palm V™ organizer. The keyboard for the Palm III organizer supports the PalmPilot™ Personal and Professional organizers, the Palm III series, and the Palm VII™ series.

**Note:** If you want to use the portable keyboard with a PalmPilot Personal or Professional organizer, you must install a different version of Keyboard.prc. You can download it from this web site: <http://www.palm.com/custsupp/downloads>

### Can I perform a HotSync® operation on the organizer while using the keyboard?

No. The keyboard does not replace the functionality of your cradle. To perform a HotSync operation after entering data with the keyboard, remove your organizer from the keyboard and place it in your cradle. Then press the HotSync button.

**Does the keyboard support international characters?**

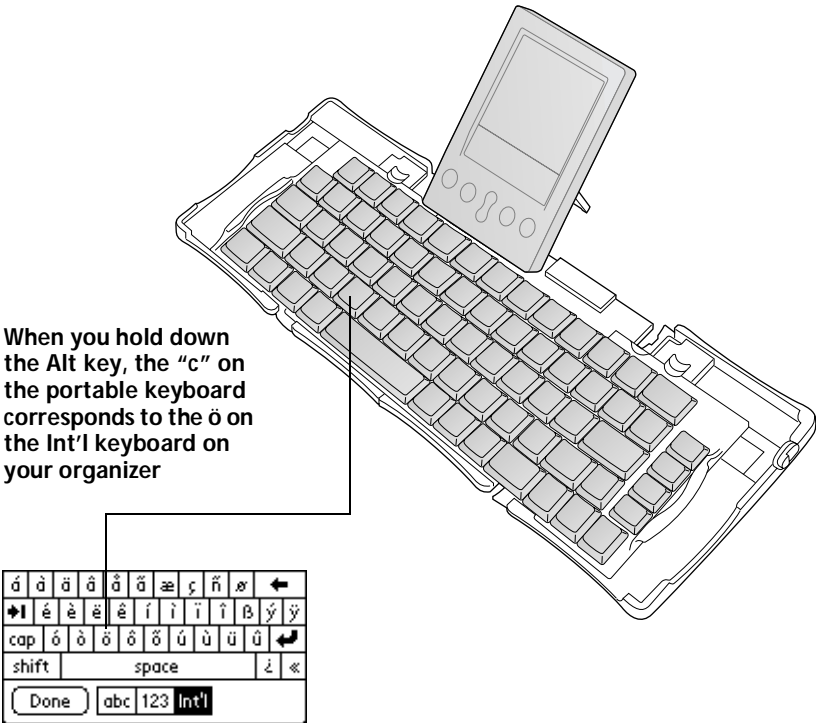
Yes. You can enter international characters in two ways:

Use keyboard shortcuts: Use the function key (Fn) in combination with another key to add accent marks to letters you type, and to type punctuation marks. See “Extended character set” earlier in this book.

For example, to type the ö in Köln, type the o, and then press Fn and ; (function key and semicolon). The umlaut appears over the o.

Use the Alt key on the portable keyboard: When you press and hold down the Alt key, the next key you press produces the character corresponding to that location on your organizer’s onscreen international keyboard.

For example, to type the ö in Köln, press and hold down Alt; then press c on your portable keyboard.



# Warranty and Other Product Information

## Limited warranty

**HARDWARE:** Palm Computing, Inc. ("Palm Computing"), warrants to the original end user ("Customer") that this product will be free from defects in workmanship and materials, under normal use, for one year from the date of original purchase from Palm Computing or its authorized reseller. Accessory products, as listed in the applicable Palm Computing catalogue, are not covered under this Limited Warranty except for the modems for the connected organizer, the cradles, cables, memory upgrades, keyboards, styli, and leather items sold under the Palm Computing® brand. Palm Computing shall not be responsible for Customer's software, firmware, information, or memory data contained in, stored on, or integrated with any products returned to Palm Computing for repair, whether under warranty or not.

**SOFTWARE:** Palm Computing warrants to Customer that the Palm™ Desktop organizer software and Palm OS® software licensed from it will perform in substantial conformance to their program specifications, for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of original purchase from Palm Computing or its authorized reseller. Palm Computing warrants the media containing software against failure during the warranty period. No updates are provided. Palm Computing does not provide any warranty for Adobe® Acrobat® Reader or any other third-party applications software that is licensed to Customer by the third party. Palm Computing's sole obligation with respect to this express warranty shall be (at Palm Computing's discretion) to refund the purchase price paid by Customer for any defective software product, or to replace any defective media with software which substantially conforms to applicable Palm Computing published specifications. Palm Computing makes no warranty or representation that its software products will meet Customer's requirements or will work in combination with any hardware or applications software products provided by third parties, that the operation of the software products will be uninterrupted or error free, or that all defects in the software products will be corrected.

Palm Computing makes no certification regarding the Year 2000 status of any other Palm Computing products.

Any Palm Computing platform application supplied by Palm Computing that makes correct use of Palm Computing platform date and time functions will not have a problem transitioning to the year 2000. The date and time utilities for the Palm Computing platform use 32 bits to store seconds, starting at January 1, 1904. This approach allows the correct representation of dates through February 5, 2040. The Date Book software currently displays dates through December 31, 2031. Provided the product is still being sold by Palm Computing, Palm Computing will make software enhancements to remove these limitations well in advance of these dates.

If it appears that any Palm Computing product does not perform properly with regard to such date-data on and after January 1, 2000, and Customer notifies Palm Computing before the later of April 1, 2000, or ninety (90) days after original purchase of the product from Palm Computing or its authorized reseller, Palm Computing shall, at its option and expense, provide a software update which would effect the proper performance of the product, repair the product, deliver to Customer an equivalent product to replace the product, or, if none of the foregoing is feasible, refund to Customer the purchase price paid for the product.

Any software update or replaced or repaired Palm Computing product will carry a Year 2000 Limited Warranty for ninety (90) days after purchase or until April 1, 2000, whichever is later.

Customers using date and time utilities other than those supplied by Palm Computing should check with the developer to determine if the software will correctly handle all of the subtle issues of date and time conversion.

**OBTAINING WARRANTY SERVICE:** Customer must contact a Palm Computing Technical Support or Customer Service center within the applicable warranty period to obtain warranty service authorization. Dated proof of original purchase from Palm Computing or its authorized reseller will be required. Palm Computing is not respon-



sible for Customer products or parts received without a warranty service authorization. In the United States, Palm Computing may ship a replacement product or part prior to receiving the original product or part ("advance exchange"). If advance exchange is not available, then the repaired product or part will be shipped as soon as reasonably possible, which will be no later than thirty (30) days after Palm Computing receives the original product or part. Repaired or replacement products will be shipped to Customer at Palm Computing's expense. The repair and replacement process for products or parts in locations outside of the United States will vary depending on Customer's location.
